A regular meeting of the Boards of Directors of the Colorado Crossing Metropolitan District Nos. 1-3 (referred to hereafter as the "Boards") was convened on Thursday, January 19, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. The Districts' Boards meeting was held via Microsoft Teams. The meeting was open to the public.

ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

Quorum/Call to Order/Disclosures of Potential Conflicts of Interest: Director Moore called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. A quorum was confirmed, and the Boards excused the absence of Director Langley.
